

Routing: Cape Town - Garden Route (Oudtshoorn, Knysna) - Mpumalanga panoramic Tour - Wildlife Safari.

ltinerary.

Day 1: On arrival in Cape Town, you will be met and transferred to your accommodation in or around the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. Half-day city tour, including the Castle of Good Hope, optional activities in the Waterfront, boat excursions to Robben Island where Mandela was held prisoner, or visit the Aquarium. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 2: Full day Cape Point Tour including Boulders beach, Simon's Town, Kirstenbosch and Hout Bay where you can do an optional island cruise. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 3: This morning, enjoy either a half day wine tour or a cultural experience. On the wine tour, you will visit wine estates, do a cellar tour, visit the old French colonial town of Franschhoek and the university town of Stellenbosch.

The cultural tour enables you to meet the ethnic people, exchange cultural values; visit the Empowerment centre where disadvantaged people are taught basic life skills; and a local shebeen.

Spend the balance of the afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 4: Depart for Oudtshoorn via Route 62 (+- 5 hours drive), known as the ostrich palace of the world. Afternoon tour of the Cango Caves is included. Overnight in Oudtshoorn.

Day 5: Enjoy a guided tour of the Cango Wildlife Sanctuary before departing for the

Garden Route. En route to Knysna, stop at Mossel Bay, George and Wilderness. After checking into your hotel, freshen up for a **sunset cruise** on the Knysna lagoon (included).

Day 6: Spend a day at leisure with optional excursions, namely, the Knysna Elephants; whale watching cruises; a glider flip over the Bay and for the adventurous visitor there is bungi jumping and the Treetop Canopy Tour. (All activities to be pre booked.)

Overnight in **Knysna**, **Plettenberg Bay** or **Tsitsikamma**.

Day 7 - 9: Depart early for a morning drive to Port Elizabeth (+- 3 hour drive). On arrival at Port Elizabeth's Airport, board a flight to Mpumalanga via Johannesburg (not included) where you will be met and transferred (not included) to a private Game Lodge in one of the Game Reserves adjacent to the Kruger National Park.

Your time is spent relaxing in search of the wildlife and "Big Five" either in an open landrover or on foot with a private game ranger and tracker. Overnight at a private Game Lodge.

Day 10: After an early breakfast, check out. Spend the morning exploring the panoramic Route (cost not included): namely the Blyde River Canyon (boat trips); the famous Bourke's Luck Potholes; Gods Window; the old mining village of Pilgrims Rest; the Cheetah breeding farm and other historical sights.

Pre-book you optional excursions for: hot air ballooning; micro-lighting over the game reserve; elephant back riding; or a visit to the Shangana Cultural Village. This afternoon board your outbound flight from Mpumalanga or Hoedspruit (not included).

Half-day city tour, including the *Castle of Good Hope*, optional activities in the Waterfront, boat excursions to *Robben Island* or visit the Aquarium. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 2: Full day Cape Point Tour, including Boulders beach, Simon's Town, Kirstenbosch & Hout Bay where you can do an optional Island cruise. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 3: This morning, enjoy either a half day wine tour or a cultural experience. On the wine tour, you will visit wine estates, do a cellar tour, visit the old French colonial town of Franschhoek and the university town of Stellenbosch.

The *cultural tour* enables you meet ethnic people, exchange cultural values; visit the Empowerment centre where disadvantaged people are taught basic life skills. Spend the balance of the afternoon at leisure. Optional Table Mountain tour, weather permitting. Overnight in Cape Town.

Day 4: Depart for *Oudtshoorn* via route 62, known as the ostrich palace of the world. Afternoon *Cango Caves* tour is included. Overnight in Outshoorn.

Day 5: Enjoy a guided tour of the *Cango Wildlife Ranch.* En route to Knysna, stop at Mossel Bay, George and Wilderness. After checking into your hotel, freshen up for a sunset cruise on the *Knysna Lagoon* (included).

Day 6: Spend a day at leisure with optional excursions to the Knysna Elephants; whale watching cruises in season; a glider flip over the Bay and for the more adventurous visitor there is bungi jumping and the Treetop Canopy tour. (All activities to be pre booked.) Overnight in Knysna, Plettenberg Bay or Tsitsikamma.

Day 7: Depart early for a 3-hour drive to Port Elizabeth. On arrival at Port Elizabeth's Airport, board a flight to Durban Airport (not included). Collect your vehicle or be transferred (not included) to accommodation situated on Durban's Golden Mile. Overnight in *Durban*.

Day 8: Today you will either visit an authentic *Zulu Village* or spend the day in the City visiting uShaka Marine World or walking along Marine Parade. At the Zulu Village of *Shakaland* you will witness traditional customs such as spear making; tribal dancing and the beer making ceremony. Traditional Zulu lunch will be served. Overnight in Durban.

Day 9: Depart for Umhlanga, North of Durban, for a relaxing beach vacation in the warm Indian Ocean with its golf courses and magnificent beaches. This "Sugar Coastline" is also famous for the schools of *dolphins* that play out at sea. Overnight at Umhlanga or Ballito.

Day 10: Spend your day at leisure where general facilities are excellent and bathing is safe. Overnight at *Umhlanga or Ballito*.

Day 11: Drive to Durban departing early morning and board a flight to Mpumalanga (cost not included). Routing: Johannesburg Mpumalanga / Limpopo Region Kruger National Park Johannesburg.


Day 1: You will be collected for an early morning departure from Johannesburg by road. En-route to a private Game Lodge, enjoy a tour of the Panorama Route in the beautiful Mpumalanga / Limpopo Areas, with its awesome scenic viewpoints. Once at the Game Lodge, relax around the pool before boarding the open 4x4 vehicle for a night game drive in search of nocturnal wildlife and predators. Overnight at the Game Lodge.

Day 2: Enjoy a full day of game viewing and bird watching in the Kruger National Park. After a picnic breakfast, continue southwards towards the open plains of the park, renowned for large herds of giraffe, zebra and antelope. Overnight at the Game Lodge.

Day 3: (This day is excluded for the 4 Day Safari). After breakfast, visit the Rehabilitation Centre for orphaned animals and birds. Return to your accommodation for a siesta. In the afternoon, relax on a game drive to the Olifants River. Return to camp spotlighting animals along the way. Overnight at the Game Lodge.

Day 4: This morning we will be covering the northern part of the Kruger Park. This area boasts some of the biggest Tuskers (elephants) in Africa. The northern zone, which has all the species found in the south, offers opportunities of seeing rare antelope such as sable, roan, eland and tsessebe. Overnight at the Game

Day 5: After an early morning game walk and breakfast, depart for Johannesburg arriving back at approximately 17h00 - 18h00 (51/2 hours

Itinerary:


Day 1: Fly in a 29-seater SA Airlink Jetstream to Phalaborwa Airport, where you will be welcomed by your resident ranger. Depending on the time of arrival, on your first day you will either enter Kruger Park immediately or else drive to the private Game Lodge. Depart on an evening game drive in an open vehicle in search of nocturnal wildlife and predators. Dinner is in the boma and will be a traditional African meal. Overnight at the Game Lodge.

Day 2: (This day is repeated for the 4 Day option.) Enter the Kruger National Park at sunrise for a full day of game viewing and bird watching. The abundance of prey species like zebra, wildebeest, giraffe and impala ensures a high concentration of predators in the zone. Dinner will be in a reeded boma around a log fire under the African stars. Overnight at the Game Lodge.

Day 3: Johannesburg

Depending on your flight departure on this day, you will either have a bush walk followed by a visit to the Cheetah Park or spend another morning game driving before departing to Phalaborwa Airport for your return flight to Johannesburg.

Routing: Johannesburg Mpumalanga/Limpopo Panoramic Route Kruger National Park / Private Game Reserve Rocktail Bay Reefs Richards Bay.

Itinerary:

Day 1: After checking into your Johannesburg accommodation, depart for either a cultural or historical experience.

At **Lesedi Cultural Village** learn about ethnic tribes. Participate in tribal dancing and an African dinner feast; or be entertained at **Gold Reef City** with its shops, viewings of a restored gold mine workings and various fun rides.

Day 2: After breakfast, depart for Mpumalanga (about a 5 hour journey)





Overnight.

Here, red dunes and scrub fade into infinity and herds of gemsbok, springbok, eland and blue wildebeest follow the seasons; imposing camel thorn trees provide shade for huge black-maned lions and are a vantage point for leopard, cheetah, spotted hyena and many raptors. Overnight in chalets at camps within the Park.



Routing: East London - Coffee Bay - Umtata, the capital city of Transkei - Nelson Mandela's home village "Qunu" - Nelson Mandela Museum - Xhosa Villages -Port St. Johns .

Itinerary:

Day 1: Travel from East London on the N2 to Coffee Bay, close to Butterworth. Stop to visit two nearby waterfalls - the Gcuwa Falls and the Bowa Falls. Coffee Bay is a misty, untouched bay in the heart of the Wild Coast. Enjoy excellent fishing; spectacular walks; surfing; scuba diving; golf and an abundance of bird life in the area. A must see is the "hole in the wall", a geological marvel with the sea views between an overhanging rock with a hole large enough for a double-decker bus to fit through. Overnight in Coffee Bay on a bed and breakfast basis.

Day 2: Depart for *Umtata*, the capital of Transkei, and spend your day following the early footsteps of *Nelson Mandela's* youth at his home village, "Qunu". Enjoy your day at leisure visiting the Nelson Mandela Museum and *Xhosa Villages*. Here you will enjoy an insight into the traditions and customs of the Xhosa people of this region. Overnight in Umtata on a bed and breakfast basis.

Day 3: After breakfast depart for the small coastal town of *Port St Johns* with its unparalleled natural beauty and relaxing lifestyle. The Xhosa culture, both traditional and modern, is always apparent from the Sangoma strolling along in all his finery; the thumping sound of Kwaito music from a furniture store to dodging the ever-present voracious mini-bus taxis. This town is surrounded with wonderful sights and experiences. There is plenty to challenge the energetic traveller namely diving; climbing and trekking. Overnight in Port St. Johns on a bed and breakfast basis.

Day 4: Travel back along the N2 from Port St. Johns to East London.

This guided tour enables you to become part of the "City of Learning" of history, culture and political martyr's of the ANC (African National Congress), within the old Ciskei Republic in the Eastern Cape.

Routing: Port Elizabeth: Addo Elephant National Park - Grahamstown (Educational & National Arts Festival in the first week of July) - King Williams Town (Xhosa & English historical warfare's) - Hogsback (indigenous forests and waterfalls).

Itinerary:

Day 1: Depart Port Elizabeth and spend the morning visiting the Addo Elephant National Park with its wildlife including rhino, lion, buffalo and off course elephant in their natural habitat. After lunch, continue onto Grahamstown, which is known as "The City of Saints" or "The City of Learning". This cultural city boasts a wide variety of interesting sites, including Rhodes University, historical early settler architecture and monuments. Overnight in Grahamstown.

Day 2: After breakfast, depart for *King William's Town*, established in 1826. After various wars between the British Settlers and the Xhosa, the town developed into a prosperous trade centre for the regional tribes. Overnight in King William's Town.

Day 3: After breakfast, depart for the beautiful village of *Hogsback*, situated on the slopes of the Amatole Mountains. There are large tracts of indigenous forest with 4 beautiful waterfalls,





where the rich variety of bird life includes parrot and Loerie. In windy conditions, the Kettle Spout Waterfall arches up in a feathery plume some 9m high. Overnight in Hogsback.

Day 4: Depart from Hogsback and travel back to Port Elizabeth via *Fort Beaufort*.

5 Day Wild Coast Pondo Walking Safari (See Annex 9 for rates)

This true wilderness trail is for the nature lover, birding enthusiast and the adventurous. The terrain is spectacular, but fairly strenuous. Hikers will be based at a beautifully revamped River Lodge, in the heart of the Pondoland Park, situated on the coast. Hikers walk out daily with a trained local guide.

Routing: East London - Wild Coast - East London.

Itinerary:


Day 1: On arrival in East London, depart for the Lodge either by self-drive or a transfer (not included). Settle in, relax and enjoy the ambiance of the River Lodge.

Day 2: 13 km Illityelentaka. This relatively short walk takes hikers south along the coast, returning inland via isolated villages where you will meet the friendly Pondo folk who live in these areas. The views are spectacular and the small remote white sandy beaches offer an opportunity for a quick swim. Enjoy the solitude of this paradise.

Day 3: 22 km Waterfall Bluff. We recommend an early start for this trail. The route is across beautiful unspoiled beaches, up an escarpment and along the cliff top with magnificent views. Although it is strenuous, it's a one-way walk and the magnificent views and frequent sightings of dolphins & whales (in season) is a rich reward. Hikers reach a waterfall that cascades into the sea. After crossing the Mhlankulu River there is an opportunity to swim in the pristine river pool. In the late afternoon the sight of the River Lodge and a cold beer will be a welcome sight.

Day 4: 14 km Magwa Falls. This trail leads hikers away from the coast, up a valley, through a section of natural forest before climbing up an escarpment. Before reaching the magnificent Magwa waterfall, hikers will walk through a section of tea plantations offering magical views and an insight into the daily lives of the families living in these remote hills. Hotel Management will collect hikers from the falls, visiting two more waterfalls en route back to the hotel. The trail on this day may be substituted for a wilderness/forest trail, at the hiker's choice.

Day 5: Return to East London for your onward bound flight (flight not included).



Routing: Drakensberg Mountains; Manyeleti Game Reserve, Kruger National Park & Letaba Ranch Game Reserve

Itinerary:

Day 1: Depart early morning from Johannesburg, travelling through rural South Africa to the *Drakensberg Mountains*.
